

# ANTIPHONS FOR THE ELEVATION OF THE HOLY CROSS

September 14

(Chant antiphon verses on Sundays from September 14 to 21)

## First Antiphon (Psalm 21, LXX)

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

1. Ὁ Θεός, ὁ Θεός μου, πρόσχες μοι, ἰνατί, ἐγκατέλιπές με;
2. Μακρὰν ἀπὸ τῆς σωτηρίας μου οἱ λόγοι τῶν παραπτωμάτων μου.
3. Σὺ δὲ ἐν ἀγίῳ κατοικεῖς, ὁ ἔπαινος τοῦ Ἰσραὴλ.

Refrain: Ταῖς πρεσβείαις τῆς Θεοτόκου...

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

1. My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?
2. Why are You so far from helping Me, and from the words of My groaning?
3. But You are holy, enthroned in the praises of Israel.

Refrain: Through the intercessions of the Theotokos...

## Second Antiphon (Psalm 73, LXX)

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

1. Ἰνατί, ὁ Θεός, ἀπόσω εἰς τέλος;
2. Μνήσθητι τῆς συναγωγῆς σου, ἧς ἐκτίσω ἀπ' ἀρχῆς· ὄρος Σιών τοῦτο, ὃ κατεσκίηνωσας ἐν αὐτῷ.
3. Ὁ δὲ Θεὸς βασιλεὺς ἡμῶν πρὸ αἰώνων, εἰργάσατο σωτηρίαν ἐν μέσῳ τῆς γῆς.

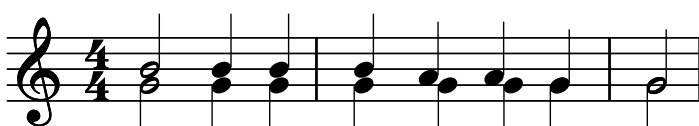
Refrain:

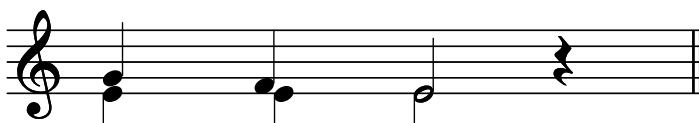

*Chant the Apolytikion of the the Holy Cross. Then...*
