

## ANTIPHONS FOR THEOPHANY



January 6, *Sundays from January 6 to 14.*

### First Antiphon (Psalms 113, LXX), *Verses in Second Tone:*

1. When Israel went out of Egypt, the house of Jacob from a people of strange language, Judah became His sanctuary.
  2. The sea saw it and fled; Jordan turned back.
  3. What ails you, O sea, that you fled? O Jordan, that you turned back?
- Refrain: Through the Intercessions...*

### Second Antiphon (Psalm 114, LXX), *Verses in Second Tone:*

1. I love the Lord, because He has heard My voice and my supplications, because He has inclined His ear to me, therefore I will call upon Him as long as I live.
  2. The pains of death surrounded me, And the pangs of Sheol laid hold of me.
  3. Gracious is the Lord, and righteous; Yes, our God is merciful.
- Refrain:*






## SMALL ENTRANCE HYMN FOR THEOPHANY
